Follow the steps to complete your career exploration project.

1. Login to your laptop and open your internet browser.
2. Visit <http://www.onetonline.org>
3. In the top right corner, locate the "Occupation Quick Search" search bar. In the search bar, type the career title you would like to research. Click the white arrow.
4. A list of careers will appear on the next page. Click the title of the career you would like to research.
5. Click or scroll to the Skills section. Read the information. Click or scroll to the Abilities section. Read the information and write a summary of what you have learned on a loose leaf. (See teacher Example)
6. Click or scroll to the Work Values section. Read the information and write your summary on your loose leaf of what you learned.
7. Click or scroll to the Tools Used section. Read the information. Write a summary of what you have learned on your loose leaf.
8. Click or scroll to the Tasks section. Read the information. Click or scroll to the Work Activities section. Read the information and write a summary of what you learned on your loose leaf.
9. Click or scroll to the Education section. Read the information and write a summary of what you learned on your loose leaf.
10. Choose other sections to explore, such as Wages and Employment or Related Occupations and write a summary of the other information you learned about your career in your loose leaf.
11. Submit your loose leaf to the teacher.
